### How They Work:

Liners offer the same features as the internal base of the Plant Nappy but with one key difference, the liner is removable.

Should you find yourself with a frequent drip or spill, the liner would absorb oils and fuels until it reaches its capacity, at this point you could remove the liner and clean out the oil or replace the liner with a new one to utilise the lifespan of the Plant Nappy.

### Construction:

PVC coated polyester fabric outer  
Polypropylene fibre filler

### Compatibility:

Good resistance to water, oil and a wide range of chemicals over short-term exposure.

### Disposal:

Plant nappies and liners contaminated with oil and fuel must be treated as hazardous waste and be disposed of according to current regulations.

### Safety Data:

Low weights ensure safe handling in accordance with Manual handling guidelines.  
Further technical advice is available if required.
